 - a. WebAdvisor Log In:
 - Your user ID is formatted: f.lastname####
 - \succ **f** is the first character of your first name (no nicknames).
 - lastname is your last name up to 20 characters.
 - ➤ #### is the last four digits of your Student ID.
 - b. WebAdvisor Password:

Your default password is **"Temp"** and your **6 digit date of birth. (TempMMDDYY). NOTE: Your password is case sensitive.**

- After you log in for the first time with the default password you will be asked to change your password.
- 6. Once logged in on Web Advisor, click on the "Current Students" icon.
- 7. Under "Academic Planning" click "Online Orientation."
- 8. Make sure your student ID and information is correct. For College select **"CHC Crafton Hills College"**. For Type you may select **"English"** or **"Accessible."** Click **"Submit."**
- 9. Click the "Go to Website" link.
- 10. Once you review each slide, click **"next."** There will be review questions throughout the orientation that you will need to answer. You can review your progress by clicking the **"progress"** icon.
- 11. Once entire online orientation is complete, click **"submit."** You must complete the satisfaction survey. The link is on the final page.

steps to SOA³R

Seniors at your high school may participate in the SOA³R program to complete the Crafton Hills College new student enrollment process before graduating. This process gives you a head start over other new students entering Crafton Hills College.

Online Orientation provides you with an introduction to Crafton Hills College and information about the programs and services offered. The Online Orientation must be completed prior to taking the Assessment test. It will prepare you for the transition into college. A step by step guide on how to access the Online Orientation is located on the back of the brochure.

Application to Crafton Hills College is the first step in your enrollment. Crafton Hills College staff will be available at your high school to assist you with the application process and answer any questions you have about the process. A step by step guide on how to apply to the college is located on the following page of this brochure.

Assessment Assessment provides you with placement in the English and math courses you will start with when you enter college. Once you have completed the Online Orientation, you may log onto Web Advisor to complete the placement questionnaire.

Advising provides you with the opportunity to meet with a counselor from Crafton Hills College in a group setting at your high school. The counselor will review your assessment results and help you put together an initial educational plan which will include at least two semesters of suggested courses.

Registration for students who have completed SOAR is two steps higher than open enrollment. This means you will have a better chance at getting the classes you want at the times you want them.
