

## RHS Seniors Steps to SOA<sup>3</sup>R

All students who complete the following steps will be guaranteed a **“Priority E”** status (two steps higher than open enrollment) for registration. *This means you will have a better chance to get the classes you want at the times you want them.*

**Follow the steps below and be ready to sign up for fall classes without a visit to Crafton Hills College.**

**On your own:** You must complete the following steps before you come to the SOA<sup>3</sup>R Kick Off meeting

1. **Apply for Admission** – Go to the Crafton Hills College web page and complete the application for admission. In the brochure are detailed instructions for completing an application. This process can be completed anywhere you have internet access.
2. **Complete the Online Orientation** – After you apply you will receive an email with your new student ID number. Using this number, log onto Web Advisor through the Crafton Hills College web page and complete the New Student Online Orientation. In the brochure are detailed instructions for completing an application. This process can be completed anywhere you have internet access.
3. **Complete Online Assessment** – Assessment provides you with placement in the English and Math courses you will start with when you enter college. Once you have completed the Online Orientation, you may log onto Web Advisor to complete the placement questionnaire.

If you would like help with the application, Online Orientation, and/or Online Assessment, Crafton Hills College will hold workshops on **Wednesday, February 26 from 2:45 pm – 3:45 pm in the Student Center.**

### **At RHS:**

1. **Attend the MANDATORY SOA<sup>3</sup>R Kick-off meeting – Tuesday, February 25 from 2:45 pm – 4:45 pm in the Grace Mullen Auditorium.** If you wish to participate in SOA<sup>3</sup>R you are required to attend this meeting. An additional help session will be available the day after Kick Off. All students must bring a current copy of their high school transcript with them to kick-off and their CHC Student ID number.
2. **Attend advisement – Tuesday, March 3 from 2:45 pm – 5:45 pm in the Library, Room 108 and Room 110.** In a group setting, a CHC counselor will review your assessment and develop an initial student educational plan (SEP) while discussing your educational goals. If you passed any AP (Advanced Placement) with a score of 3, 4 or 5 bring a copy of your AP scores with you to the advisement session. If you completed any dual enrollment courses bring a copy of your unofficial college transcripts with you to advisement. The unofficial college transcript can be accessed in your college Web Advisor.
