#### International Student Admission Checklist

- Crafton Hills College Application: Apply online at [www.craftonhills.edu](http://www.craftonhills.edu). Please note that as an international student, receiving a student identification number does not guarantee admission into Crafton Hills College. Applicants must complete both the [Crafton Hills College online application](#), and the [International Students Application](#).
- **Affidavit of Financial Support** (must be in English): All international students must provide proof of financial support for tuition, fees, books, supplies and living expenses for two academic year at the current estimated cost rate. The bank letter/statements (within the last 6 months) must be from a personal checking/savings accounts. No screenshots, transaction histories, are accepted. The current estimated cost for one academic is \$18,636.
- Official transcripts from all high/secondary schools and colleges/universities attended (applicants must be a high/secondary school graduates).
