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I. INTRODUCTION

On January 8-11 & 16, 2018, Keenan & Associates conducted a Property & Liability Inspection for the San Bernardino Community College District, located in San Bernardino, California. The purpose of the inspection is to assist the District with their Property & Liability Loss Prevention Program. Kendall Evans, Loss Control Consultant, conducted the inspection, and Melissa Morris, Sr. Project Coordinator, processed the report.

II. ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

Keenan & Associates would like to thank all of the individual site personnel for their assistance and cooperation during the site inspections.

III. LIMITATIONS

A sincere effort was made to conduct a thorough inspection of the schools, associated properties, and playgrounds. This effort was directed at identifying unsafe conditions within these properties. The observations are based upon conditions observed at the time of the inspection and were apparent to the inspector.

The information contained in this report does not certify that the schools, District Office, Maintenance facilities, grounds, equipment, material, or operations are in compliance with any federal, state, or local law, rule, or regulation. The information in this report does not conclude that all possible conditions, hazards, or hazardous conditions were observed or reported.

The goal of our inspection was to (i) assist the client in evaluating it's self-audit procedures, (ii) facilitate the identification of conditions which may pose a risk of injury and/or property damage, and (iii) provide recommendations and/or suggestions to help mitigate the risks identified. VI. SUMMARY

The San Bernardino Community College District serves 22 cities in the inland Southern California area and serves an additional 25,000 students each year at Crafton Hills College and San Bernardino Valley College. The District has additional locations/ properties at Alternate Text Production Center, Technology & Educational Services, San Bernardino CCD Annex, The Applied Technology Training Center (ATTC), and the Professional Development Center (PDC); both located at the District Office. The Alternate Text Production Center and Technology & Educational Support Services are both leased properties. The San Bernardino CCD Annex is a location that the District is not currently renting or occupying.

The District has completed their extensive construction plan at both campuses. Measure M has provided the majority of the funding for the District's construction and remodeling. Many of the buildings throughout Crafton Hills and San Bernardino Valley College have been remodeled. The most recent completed projects at San Bernardino Valley College were the new Gymnasium and Stadium Buildings.

The District continues to take a proactive approach to correcting the recommendations that were made from the pervious inspection and follow-up audit. Please see the sections below to identify some recommendations noted during the P&L inspection. Many of these issues can be easily rectified with preventative maintenance and self-inspections.

VII. LOSS EXPERIENCE REVIEW

San Bernardino Community College District has had one property losses since the beginning of 2014-2015 policy year, for a total incurred of \$8,677.70. One claim of a stolen Transit van.

On the liability side, there have been eleven claims filed since the beginning of 2014-2015 policy year, with a total incurred of \$492,442.56. There were four employment practice liability claims, for a total incurred of \$275,943.25; one claim where a disabled student alleges that she slipped in a puddle of water while entering a bathroom stall, for a total incurred of zero dollars loss to date; one claim where claimant alleges he was riding his bike on paved road and hit an unmarked speed bump that was slanted to right, for a total incurred of \$35,000.00; one claim where the claimant alleges he was falsely accused of making criminal threats and was subsequently detained, for a total incurred of \$40,788.11; one claim where claimant alleges she was sexually harassed and retaliated against for reporting the harassment, for a total incurred of \$80,000.00; one claim where a contractor alleges the District breached the contract, resulting in substantial damages, for a total incurred of \$60,000.00; one claim of copyright infringement, for a total incurred of \$711.20; and one claim where there was a misuse of Cal Card for personal items, for a total incurred of zero loss to date.

III. FROGRAM REVIEW			
Security			
Priority: EFFECTIVE			
Survey Findings:			
The security staff have received the 20 hour required class. The College does retain private security for off hours. The City/County provides security enforcement. There are intrusion alarms throughout the sites that are monitored by an outside vendor. The College has security cameras on the campuses. The College does not have enclosed perimeter fencing. Lighting is adequate in the parking lots, campus walkways, and athletic fields when they are being used. Per the College, the laptops and valuables are to be stored in an interior corridor/room. The District has cages and covers on most exterior water pipes, copper fittings, and valves. The solar panels are regularly inspected.			
Corrective Action:			
The College should continue to work on caging and covering exterior water pipes, copper fittings, and valves to help mitigate any copper theft.			
Emergency Preparedness			
Priority: EFFECTIVE			
Survey Findings:			
Per the College, the site comprehensive safety plans are not currently up to date. The College campuses conduct mock emergency drills. They have emergency supplies at each campus.			
Corrective Action:			
The site comprehensive safety plans should be updated as needed.			
Fire Prevention			
Priority: EFFECTIVE			
Survey Findings:			
Per the College, their kitchen hoods, fire extinguishers, and sprinkler systems are serviced at the required intervals. The fire extinguishers are being inspected monthly and initialed on the tag. At the time of the inspection, some fire extinguishers were not up to date on the tag initialing. The fire alarms are tested. The trash cans are emptied regularly to keep from overflowing and are stored away from building eaves. The combustible materials are stored away from public access. There is surveillance/security/lighting systems in obscured material storage areas. The College does utilize an anonymous reporting system for high frequency arson areas.			
Corrective Action:			
The campuses should be inspecting the fire extinguishers on a monthly basis and initialing the tag.			
Playground Safety			
Priority: ABSENT/INEFFECTIVE			

Playground supervisors are trained annually regarding their duties. The college does not have a formal, documented system for inspecting the playground equipment and surfacing. There is no budget/plan in place to replace old/deteriorating playground equipment or surfacing material. There were many common issues that were noted during the inspection: low loose fill under the play equipment and missing age signage on playground.

Corrective Action:

The college should have a formal, documented system for inspecting play equipment and surfacing. There were a few safety issues that are noted in the report with regards to the playground safety.

Chemical Safety
Priority: EFFECTIVE
Survey Findings:
There is a Chemical Inventory performed annually for the District. Per the College, the chemical hygiene plan and training are up to date. The College does have a policy on employees bringing chemicals/cleaners from sources outside the College. The eyewash/deluge showers are well maintained and tested regularly. All students are to wear PPE while conducting science experiments.
Corrective Action:
None at this time.
Forklift/Utility Cart
Priority: EFFECTIVE
Survey Findings:
There is a key control program in place and all utility carts require a key to operate. The College does have a utility cart plan/policy in place and they do provided safety training. They do regularly inspect/maintenance on the utility carts.
Corrective Action:
None at this time.

Pest Management

Priority: ABSENT/INEFFECTIVE

Survey Findings:

There has not been a written Integrated Pest Management policy developed. This program is not reviewed or distributed annually. There is no coordinator for this program assigned. The annual and individual registry notifications are not made. Employees that may apply pesticides have not been assigned nor completed the DPR-approved Healthy Schools Act training course before making a pesticide application. This is not done annually for teachers and has not been done during the renewal period for licensed pesticide applicators. They are not keeping the records of pesticide applications made by District staff and pest management contractors for at least four years.

Corrective Action:

The Pest Management program should be reviewed and distributed annually. There should be a coordinator for this program. The individual notification registry notifications should be made annually. The Healthy Schools

Act (HSA) training course should be done annually for teachers and during the renewal period for licensed pesticide applicators. The records of pesticide applications made by District Staff and pest management contractors should be kept for at least four years.

Self	Insp	ection
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Priority: IN PROGRESS

Survey Findings:

The College does not have a formal, documented self inspection system. When there are work orders generated, they are prioritized and corrective actions provided. If it is a hazard abatement related work order the average lag time is seven days.

Corrective Action:

The College should implement a formal, documented self inspection system that is conducted regularly.

Injury and Illness Prevention Plan

Priority: EFFECTIVE

Survey Findings:

The College has an Injury and Illness Prevention Plan, but it is not updated. They have a person identified having responsibility and authority for safety and health. Employees do receive training on the Injury Illness Prevention Plan. Many different methods are utilized to ensure safety-related materials are communicated to employees. They have procedures in place to prioritize and correct any unsafe/unhealthy conditions in a timely manner. There is employee safety training programs and accident investigation programs in place. They have systems in place to ensure that employees comply with safe and healthy work practices.

Corrective Action:

The College should update the Injury Illness Prevention Plan (IIPP) regularly.

IX. RISK TRANSFER PROCEDURES

Keenan's risk transfer forms, such as for field trips, facilities use agreements, and contractor agreements can be found on Keenan's P&C Bridge under Risk Adviser Library. The risk transfer forms can be used as is or can be modified to support the District's current procedures and policies.

X. RECOMMENDATIONS

Recommendations resulting from the inspection are listed under Site Specific or General findings. Site Specific recommendations are those that are specific in nature and pertain only to a particular site. General recommendations are those that apply to some or all sites or operations throughout the District.

Each recommendation is categorized as either Immediate, High, Medium or Low. **Immediate** is a hazard the represents a significant life-threatening danger requiring immediate attention. **High** is an exposure that, if not corrected, has the potential to result in a severe property or liability loss in the short term. **Medium** is an exposure that, while having the potential for a loss, would not normally result in a significant or severe loss. **Low** is an exposure that is commonplace throughout the District.

Immediate/High priority items are listed separately due to the severity of the exposure.

XI. IMMEDIATE/HIGH PRIORITY RECOMMENDATIONS

Priority: High

Description: The exit door to the CNTL Building Corridor 217 was chained. It is unclear why these doors are locked, but it's possible that the doors are defective and cannot be locked to the outside. Defective exit doors that do not function properly should be repaired.

Priority: High

Description: Several exit doors in this gym are chained. It is unclear why these doors are locked, but it's possible that the doors are defective and cannot be locked to the outside. Defective exit doors that do not function properly should be repaired.

Priority: High

Description: The roof had water damage in the Gym. The source of the leak should be found and repaired to mitigate the water damage hazard that was observed.

Priority: High

Description: The system trouble and/or system silence lights were lit on the main fire alarm panel. The fire alarm system should be operational at all times.

Description: The roof had severe water damage in several areas throughout the building. The source of the leak should be found and repaired to mitigate the water damage hazard that was observed.

Workroom Art Room 119 **Priority:** High

Description: Protective blade guards on table saws reduce the possibility of serious injury. Table saws that are missing protective guards should be taken out of service immediately. Missing protective guards should be replaced before the saw is placed back into service.



Location: San Bernardino Community College - SAN BERNARDINO VALLEY COLLEGE - Auditorium

Workshop A107 **Priority:** High

Description: Protective blade guards on table saws reduce the possibility of serious injury. Table saws that are missing protective guards should be taken out of service immediately. Missing protective guards should be replaced before the saw is placed back into service.

Receiving

Priority: High

Description: Compressed gas cylinders should always be secured in the upright position with a strong securing device such as a chain, strap or clamp.

Toddler Play Area **Priority:** High

Description: There is no fall-cushioning material under the equipment. Falls from equipment located on hard compacted ground can result in serious head or neck injuries. This equipment is meant only for residential play and should be removed immediately from the school site.

Facilities/MOT Plumbing

Priority: High

Description: All compressed gas cylinders should be secured in the upright position with strong securing devices (chain, straps or clamps) to prevent accidental tip-over. These heavy cylinders can injure people by falling on them directly or they can become dangerous projectiles if the regulator, cylinder valve or valve connection is damaged in a fall.



Location: San Bernardino Community College - SAN BERNARDINO VALLEY COLLEGE - LIB Building

- Library - 1st Floor **Priority:** High

Description: The roof was actively leaking by the computers, at the Reference Database and Circulation LIB 133, in the Library. The source of the leak should be found and repaired to mitigate the water damage hazard that was observed.





XII. GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS

Location: San Bernardino Community College

Priority: Medium

Description: In addition to the annual servicing, extinguishers are required to be visually inspected at least once per month in accordance with CCR Title 19 and CCR Title 24. To ensure the inspections are done, all responsible parties should initial and date the service tag that is attached to the fire extinguisher. Note: This issue was observed at all District sites, except for Crafton Hills College, which was consistent on the monthly inspections of fire extinguishers.


