# California Community Colleges

- California community colleges train 80% of firefighters, paramedics, and emergency medical technicians
- 31% of UC and 52% of CSU graduates started at a California community college
- Transfer students to UC system currently account for 48% of STEM bachelor's degrees awarded

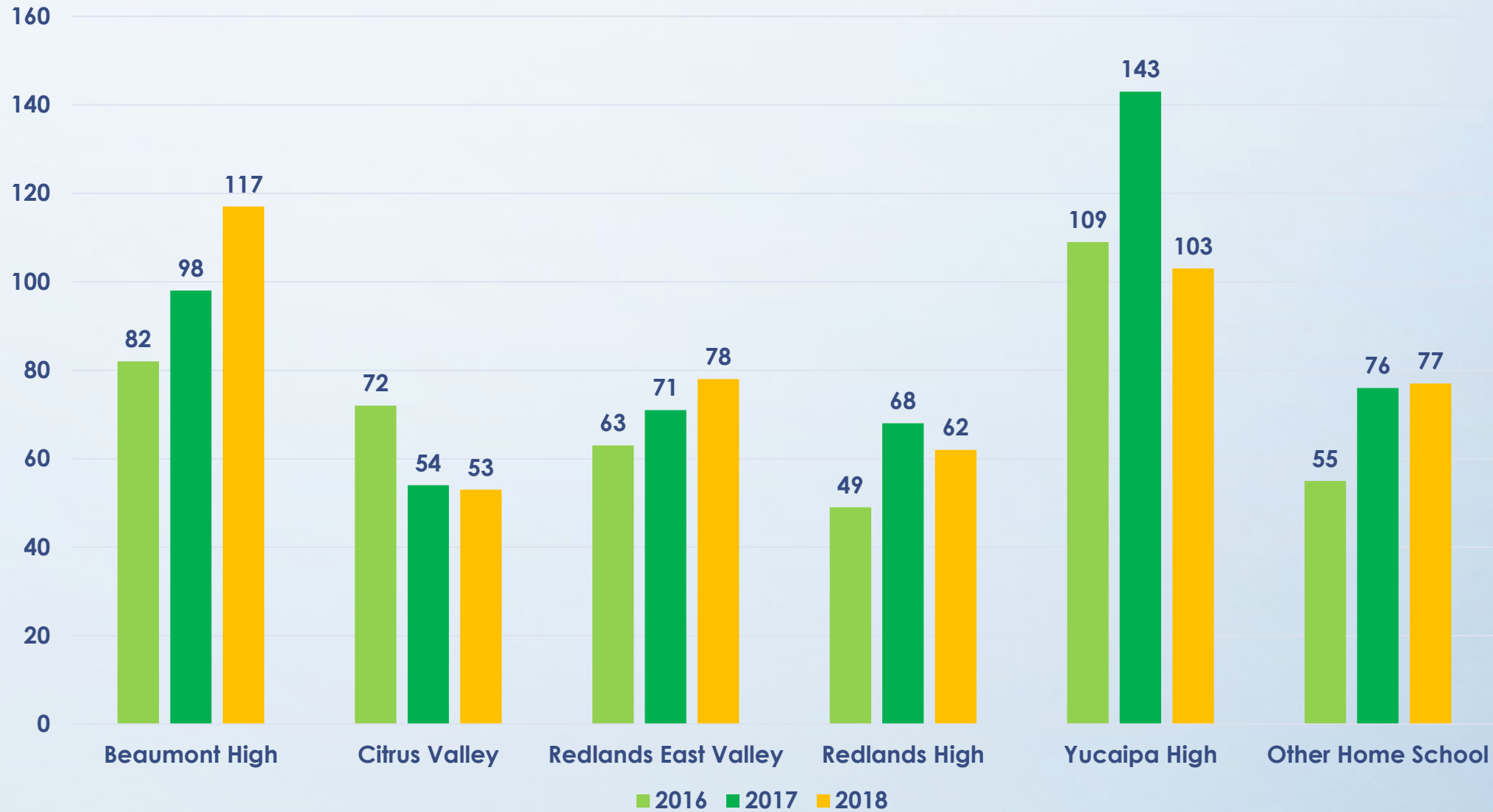

# Trend in Unduplicated Headcount by Academic Year

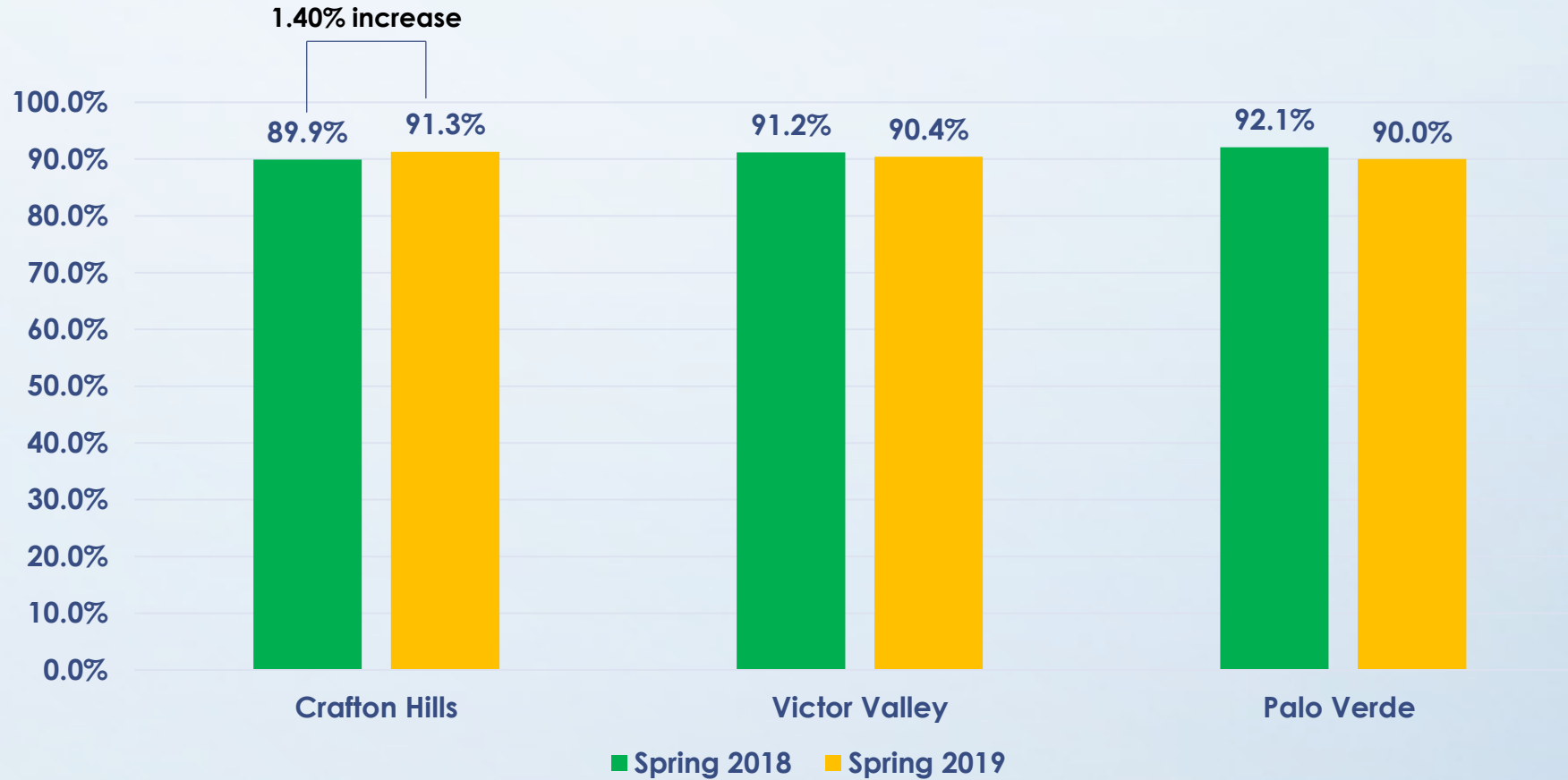

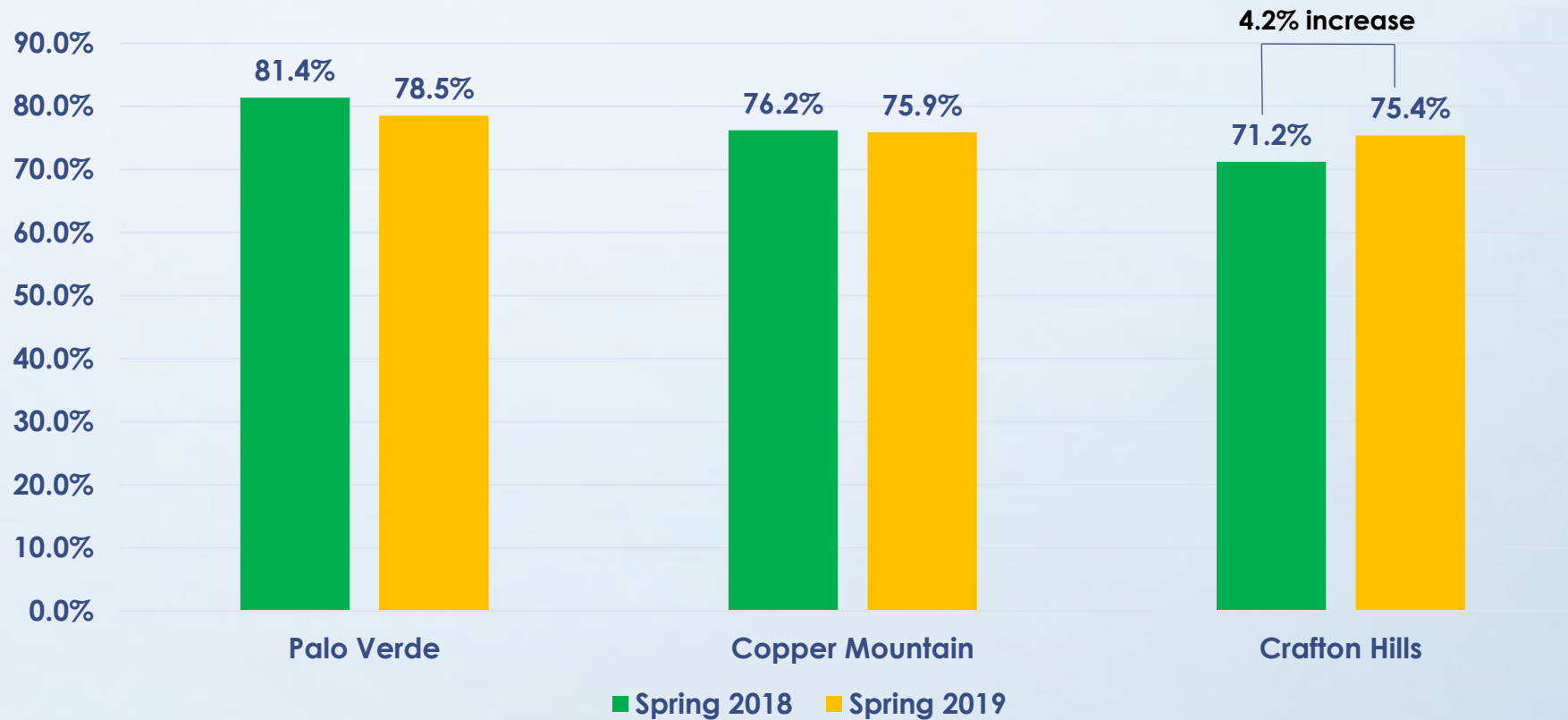

# Retention Rate Comparisons Among Top 3 California Community Colleges in Inland Empire Spring 2018 - Spring 2019



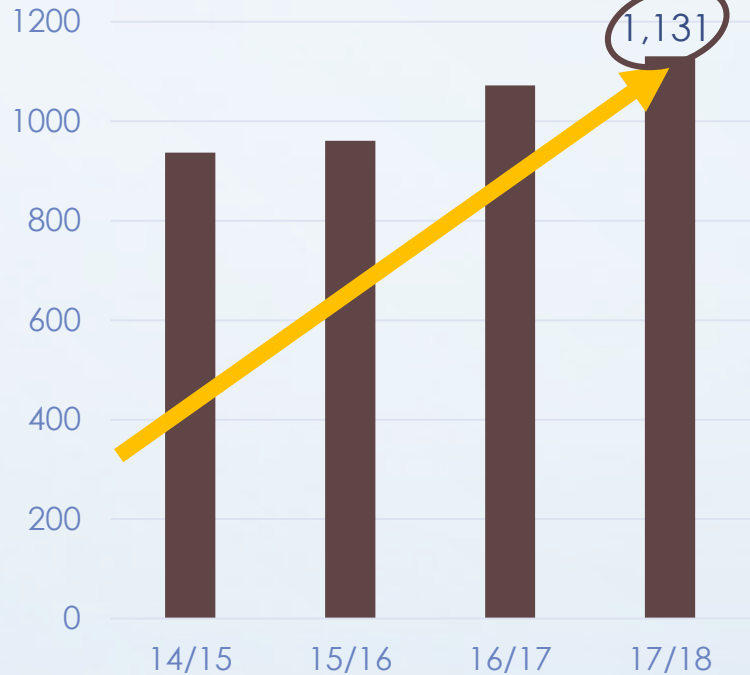

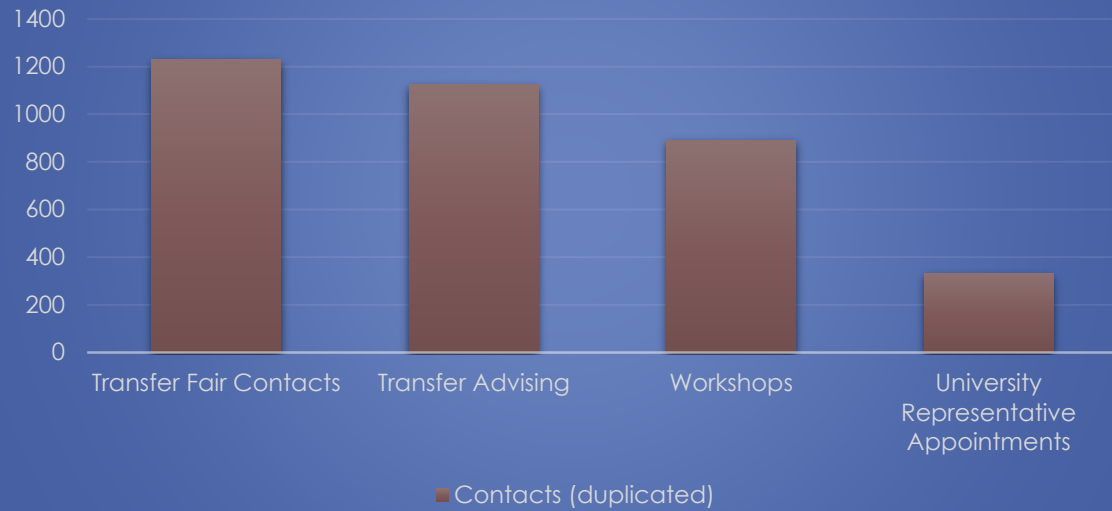

- TAG Agreements (Transfer Admission Guarantee) with UC system

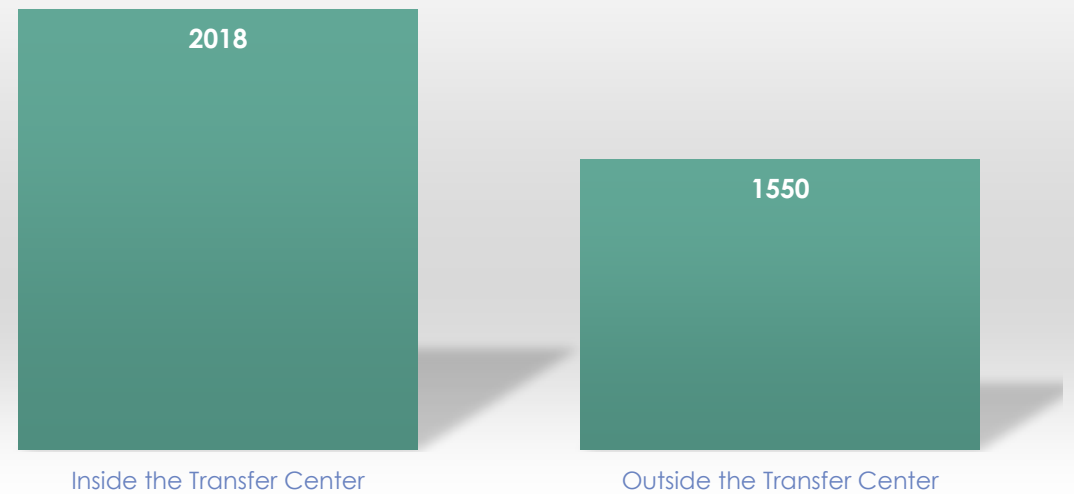
