 California community colleges train 80% of firefighters, paramedics, and emergency medical technicians

 31% of UC and 52% of CSU graduates started at a California community college

 Transfer students to UC system currently account for 48% of STEM bachelor's degrees awarded




- We serve 4,575 FTES

# Trend in Unduplicated Headcount by Academic Year






## Retention Rate Comparisons Among Top 3 California Community Colleges in Inland Empire Spring 2018 - Spring 2019


