

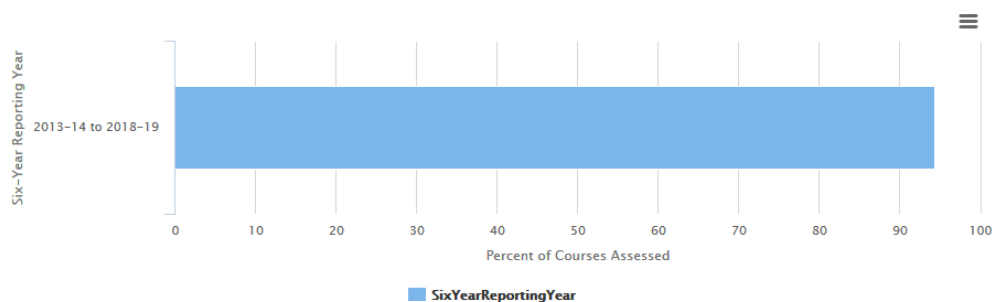
SLO Course Assessment Rate

Methodology - The SLO Course Assessment Rate includes the following courses: courses that have been offered in the last six years and primary cross listed courses. The SLO Course Assessment Rate excludes the following types of courses from the denominator: the secondary cross listed course, honors courses, and courses with enrollments of less than 8. In addition, a course was identified as needing to be assessed if hasn't been assessed in the last two complete academic years. Also, Kinesiology assessments reported in A, B, C, or D courses were treated as occurring in all four courses. Courses that are not offered during the reporting year will be removed from the denominator.

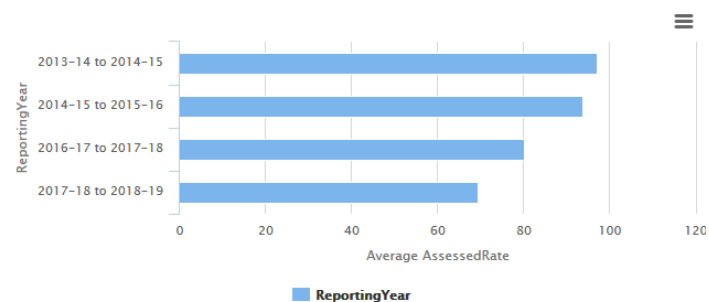
Note: The two-year reporting year periods are designed to show how Crafton is assessing in the two-year periods to help achieve the six-year assessment results of over 90% of active courses assess. Currently, any course that hasn't been assessed within a two-year reporting period is defined as needing to be assessed in the reporting year. However, courses may need to be assessed more often than every two years or less often than every two years. 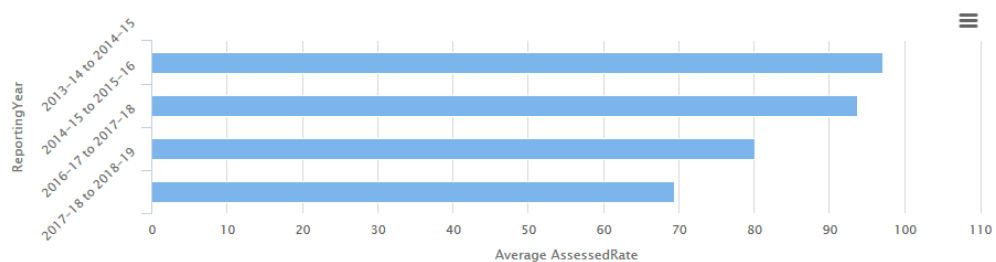
Six-Year Course Assessment Rate
