

Career and Academic Pathways

Crafton Hills College has organized their degree and certificate programs into five Career and Academic Pathways (CAPS) and created an Exploratory CAP for students who are undecided and/or wanting to explore their options at Crafton. All majors have been categorized based on areas of interest, similar career paths, common required skills, and comparable coursework requirements to help students identify which CAP aligns best with their personality, interests, and major/career goals.

Search Programs



Business and Industry

Designed for those interested in careers such as accounting, web development, and management. It also encompasses fields such as computer information systems, economics, and multimedia technology.



Creative and Fine Arts, Communication, and Design

Designed for those interested in learning a second language or pursuing careers such as music, art, and graphic design. It also encompasses fields such as digital animation, web development, and theatre.



Public Safety and Health Services

Focuses on skilled health care worker careers such as Radiology, Respiratory, Fire, EMT, and Nutrition. Also includes pathways to Nursing and other related fields.

Focuses on high tech careers related to fields such as biology, chemistry, computer science, and physics.
