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## DE Micro-courses

CHC's Distance Education Microcourses are short, optional courses that offer training in specific aspects of course design and accessibility. Completion of each microcourse will earn a completion badge which marks CHC professional development and can be shared as evidence of DE training (with current and potential employers, colleagues, etc.) and on various social media, including LinkedIn.
