Student Grievance Procedure

If you feel you have been treated unfairly, you have a right to complain. To ensure that your grievance receives a reasonable hearing, refer to [SBCCD Board Policy](#) and [Administrative Procedure 5530](#).

Grievance proceedings may be initiated against a District employee or another student for any of the following reasons:

- Any act of threat or intimidation;
- Any act of threat of physical aggression;
- Any arbitrary action or imposition of sanctions without a proper regard to academic due process as specified in college procedures.

NOTICE:

- Grades are not grieveable, but can be appealed. (See [SBCCD Administrative Procedure 4231](#)).
- Sexual harassment complaints are filed in accordance with [SBCCD Administrative Procedure 3435](#) and are not covered under Student Grievances.
- Discrimination complaints are filed in accordance with [SBCCD Administrative Procedure 3435](#) and are not covered under Student Grievances.
