BP 7260 Classified Supervisors, Managers and Administrators

(Replaces current SBCCD BP 7260)

Classified managers and supervisors are those classified administrators, regardless of job description, having significant responsibilities for formulating District policies or administering District programs other than the educational programs of the District. In addition, having authority to hire, transfer, suspend, recall, promote, discharge, assign, reward, or discipline other employees, or having the responsibility to assign work to and direct them, adjust their grievances, or effectively recommend such action.

Classified administrators shall be compensated and employed in the manner provided for by the appointment or contract of employment. Compensation shall be set by the Board upon recommendation by the Chancellor. Supervisors, Managers, Administrators, Directors, Associate Directors, and Vice Presidents shall receive up to two (2) year contracts. Executive/Vice Chancellors shall receive up to three (3) year contracts. The District chancellor shall be given a contract length determined by the Board within the limitation of the Education Code.

The Board may, with the consent of the administrator concerned, terminate, effective on the next succeeding first day of July, the terms of employment and any contract of employment with the administrator, and reemploy the administrator on any terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon by the Board and the administrator, for a new term to commence on the effective date of the termination of the existing term of employment.

If the Board determines that the administrator is not to be reemployed when his/her appointment or contract expires, notice to an administrator shall be in accordance with the terms of the existing contract. If the contract is silent, notice shall be in accordance with Education Code Section 72411.
