The budget<br>allocation is \$23,945,144 so we have a deficit of approximately<br>\$853,000. However, the state added 250 additional FTEs that<br>we are able to move forward and apply to this budget and this<br>reduces our deficit to \$536,638. We projected 4864 FTEs but<br>would like to increase this amount to 5010 FTEs so we can<br>meet our projected budget.  |  |
