Puente Research Project – Denise	Denise stated that Susana de la Pena developed a research proposal for a Puente Project here at Crafton Hills College. It was sent to the Basic Skills Committee which has a rubric to score new proposals. It passed the criteria and Basic Skills agreed to fund 40 hours in the summer and 10 hours for an annual plan if the program is given the go ahead. The plan was brought to Academic Senate which approved it. The next step is to bring it to Crafton Council for approval. Once approved, the job announcement for the research position will be advertised to the college. A couple of points were discussed: Who should the researcher report to? Vice President of Student Services or Vice President of Instruction.
