Charge: The Educational Master Planning Committee relies on evidence (e.g. quantitative and qualitative research, learning assessment results, etc.) to develop, review, and revise the Educational Master Plan with input from appropriate constituencies. It meets on the 4th Tuesday of every month.

Membership: Two Vice Presidents (VPAS, VPSS, or VPI); President, Academic Senate or designee; President, Classified Senate or designee; one CSEA representative; President, Student Senate or designee; a faculty member, Planning and Program Review Committee; Director, Institutional Advancement; three additional faculty; one Instructional Dean; Dean, Institutional Effectiveness, Research & Planning.

Term: Two years (for appointees)
