QFE-Mission, Vision and Values Review - Gio	<p>Gio visited Academic Senate and Classified Senate to discuss the drafted language for the Mission, Visions and Values. He is working with Student Senate to be placed on their next meeting agenda. Hannah indicated Gio should be on the agenda for this Friday.</p> <p>Gio provided both versions of the MVV (the one from Crafton Council and the changes received from Academic Senate). Alex stated that Classified Senate had concerns that the language was a bit too "academic" and may not resonate with students or the community.</p> <p>Gio stated that Academic Senate spent a great amount of time reviewing and editing the MMV.
