A district wide taskforce is looking at third party vendors for tracking vaccine information. The All-Campus meeting may be postponed until there is new information to share with the campus.	
Governance Training Revisions – Brandi and Gio	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gio shared a PowerPoint for <i>Effective Committees</i> which could be offered to anyone interested in the governance process. Historically, training has been offered to committee chairs on an annual basis. The council reviewed the slides which could train committee chairs and provide a great opportunity to involve more people across the community in governance.
