## Announcements – All

Kevin stated we will have our first all campus meeting this year on Friday, 2-18-22.

Kevin indicated the re-opening task force met and a proposal is on the table that would introduce a sunset date for the student vaccine mandate. The intention is to insert a sunset date to allow re-evaluation whether to continue, discontinue or modify due to the ever-changing situation. The date selected for the sunset is December 2022 and would require a decision by September 2022 if it is to be continued, discontinued or modified.

Julie asked if we will be required to wear masks indoors when we return on 2-28-22. No determination has been made by the District. It will be discussed at Chancellor's Cabinet tomorrow.

Keith stated he has been working with the math department writing a grant on equity outcomes in calculus. On Saturday, February 5, 2022, Keith and Gio presented on equity based classroom strategies to the English faculty participating in AB 705 training. The training provided course success by ethnicity data to each faculty for the classes that they taught only. In addition, each faculty were provided their class rosters with ethnicity. Keith and Gio also reviewed equity based classroom strategies to improve any identified disproportionate impact: equity based practices for syllabi, assignments, and classroom activities.

Delmy stated it is full speed ahead on planning an in-person commencement this year. We have invited the last two years graduates to walk this year since their commencement was virtual.

DSPS has streamlined the process for students to get Testing Accommodations. DSPS is emailing the Testing Accommodations Notification Form directly to instructors, eliminating the need for the student to contract each instructor individually.

The 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Gala will be held on April 21<sup>st</sup>. the theme is "Through the Years". Just sent out sponsorship packets and registration should be available next week including a \$50.00 per person discounted price for employees.
