ACCJC requires each college to set a baseline in four achievement areas. Crafton identified four standards and set the minimums. The college should not fall below the number or rate that was set. If it goes below, we need to engage in strategies to improve. Crafton is well above each of the minimum standards for all four institutional standards.

However, when you disaggregate the data it shows that under Successful Course Completion Rates by Ethnicity that we have fallen below the minimum standard we set of 63.6% for African American students. The rate for 2018/2019 is 62%. The Enrollment Strategies Committee is developing an action plan
