Gio compiled our review and we forwarded this to Christopher Crew who reviewed and combined with feedback from SBVC. This was forwarded to EMSI. This will be sent to all committee members today so you can review it before our next meeting discussion.  Our goal is to complete the new Educational Master Plan document by the end of Spring semester. In January or February the consultant which is selected will start meeting with us to help us to finalize the document.  Last year this committee started working on the Mission, Vision and Values. However, it was decided that Crafton Council was the appropriate committee for this responsibility. Hopefully this process will be complete soon and we will use this updated information in the new EMP.
