IEPI Targets (Keith)	<p>IEPI refers to the Institutional Effectiveness Partnership Initiative (IEPI).</p> <p>Last year we were required to set four targets (see handout). This year we are required to set five targets. Rather than having to go through this process each year I want to set a target for all 24 of the IEPI measures. I would like to draft a methodology and targets for us to review at the next IEPI and agree on as a committee. Then get feedback and recommendation from Senates to Crafton Council for targets.</p>
