## Discussion: Goals

- Suggestion: communication with each committee about applicable ACCJC standard(s)
- Suggestion: increase the rate of assessment
- Suggestion: identify a new ALO

- A suggestion was made to divide the standards, and give them to committees and request that they work on them during the year. The committees can agendize and goal-set around the standard they are given. Some standards may need to be given to district committees. The standards mirror our structure as an organization, it would be beneficial to bring them together.
- Keith suggested providing guidance to the committees like: review for 5 minutes, pick a section and have a dialogue about how the standard section relates to the committee, and use the information to guide future agendas.
- Chairs could come together and share work and focus.
- We need to figure out a way to increase the rate of assessment. We are at 79% of courses were assessed last year. The deans could send the form to faculty to be compensated for recording the assessment. Our goal is 100% according to the standard.
- The committee Keith Wurtz as the new ALO Members discussed the possibility of Co ALOs and what that might look like. One person is positive to have a standard voice.

Agendize discussion about compensating part time faculty for assessing classes.

The committee will recommend to the president that Keith Wurtz serve as the ALO at the end of the year, after one more report. Rebeccah will serve until June 30<sup>th</sup>.
