

Four Point Outcomes Rubric Defined

New Suggestions for Four-Point SLO Rubric

Rubric Value	Rubric Description
1	Below Basic – Student has a little or no understanding of the concept (59% or below). If assessing with dichotomous rubric, choose this option if student has not met outcome.
2	Basic – Student has a weak understanding of the concept (69-60%)
3	Proficient – Student meets or is near standard. There is a good understanding of the concept (84-70%)
4	Advanced – Student displays an advanced knowledge of the concept above the standard level (100-85%). If assessing with dichotomous rubric, choose this option if student has met outcome.

Original Rubric Suggestion

Rubric Value	Broad Rubric Description
1	No demonstrated achievement
2	Minimal evidence of achievement – below expectations
3	Adequate evidence of achievement – met stated outcome or expectations
4	Significant evidence of achievement – surpassed stated outcome, mastery or near mastery of learning expectations
