DISCIPLINE CHANGE PROPOSAL

This proposed change will now require instructors teaching courses in these areas to have a Bachelor's degree in any field and 2 years of professional experience or any Associates degree and 6 years of professional experience.

KIN/F:	From Kinesiology – Fitness Activities to Athletic Training (Kinesiology – Fitness Activities)
KIN/D:	From Kinesiology – Dance Activities to Athletic Training (Kinesiology – Dance Activities)
