COURSE MODIFICATIONS

- A. ART 121 Foundations of Three-Dimensional Design

The committee approved ART 121 as a six-year revision.

- **New Catalog Description:** This course explores the concepts, principles and techniques of three-dimensional design using a variety of materials including Wood, Plaster, Plastic, Paper, and Wire.

B. CSCI 105 Introduction to Unix/Linux
