Rationale: The Acute Care Nursing Assistant Program (ACNA) is an advanced course for the Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) to be able to perform in the acute care environment (hospital) safely and competently. The ACNA clinical is performed in a hospital and CNAs are upskilled with theoretical concepts and skills required in that environment. The students are rotating in medical-surgical, telemetry and emergency room environments.
