Kim provided an update on the movement to Maverick. There were a few glitches like duplicating and providing the incorrect date. A push was completed last Thursday that should correct this.

Troy provided the following updates. Title 5 has changed; the effective date is Fall 2025. GE pattern/pathway to be aligned with Cal-GETC. IGETC will migrate to Cal-GETC, and some courses will need to be resubmitted to see if they qualify. The Ethnic Studies graduation requirement is believed to be effective fall 2024, but implementation guidelines for Fall 2025 GE changes may override that. More information is expected from the State Chancellor's Office this week. AB1111 Common Course Numbering project has a requested effective date change to 2027.
