Answer the questions in order, NUMBERED and LETTERED in the prescribed format below. Yes, you **MUST** do it that way. YOU AUTOMATICALLY FAIL THE WHOLE ASSIGNMENT IF YOU DON'T!

Write an answer for each of the following questions (again, numbered, in order, according to prescribed format):

APPLY the three main criteria (re: Lecture #16) that many historians and political scientists use to determine what makes for a great, good and/or successful president (applied retrospectively; that is, many years after he has left office) to

- I. One president from either the 19th or 20th Century that you consider **great, good and/or successful who generally met all three of the main criteria**, noting some of his accomplishments that qualify **specifically under each criteria**:**

 1. Responding to Crisis (or Crises)
 2. Utilizing the Office for Leadership and Good Public Policy
 3. Leaving the Nation Better Off

- II. One president from either the 19th or 20th Century that you consider weak, poor and/or unsuccessful and why he may be considered a **failure specifically under the same criteria as above, and why**:**

 1. (Not) Responding to Crisis (or Crises)

2. (Not) Utilizing the Office for Leadership and Good Public Policy
3. (Not) Leaving the Nation Better Off

DO NOT CITE: George Washington, Abraham Lincoln, Theodore Roosevelt, Franklin D. Roosevelt, Warren G. Harding or William Henry Harrison; nor ANY PRESIDENT OF THE 21st Century! (Anyone who cites any of these aforementioned presidents and/or G.W. Bush, Barack Obama, or Donald Trump **will automatically fail the entire assignment!**)

IMPORTANT:

*****Full source citation in a **BIBLIOGRAPHY/WORKS CITED SECTION** is required for all the sources used for this assignment.

*******HOWEVER:** YOU DO NOT HAVE TO USE FOOTNOTES OR ENDNOTES FOR EACH CITATION (though you may do so, if so you choose). Just **BE CONSISTENT** and **make sure to cite web sources properly.**
