Handouts were shared to give the committee an idea of what this could potentially look like at Crafton. Rebeccah wants input on if we think this would be a good idea for CHC. AVID program would have a large PD responsibility. There is no student enrollment requirement and should be looked at for our whole student population. Costs ranged from \$5,500 to \$29,000. AVID deliverables for the cost include: Resources, PD materials, syllabi for first year seminar, monthly coaching calls, registration for various workshops and conferences, models for success, subscription to AVID magazine, assistance in grant writing, and other program materials. Rebeccah believes this is a cost that would fit appropriately into Equity Funding and that the SEE committee would likely approve these costs. The question lies: Do we want to adopt this as a new program (or not), or take pieces of it and use it as glue to hold together and improve the programs we already have? The next AVID conference will be January 30-31, 2018.
