

Office 365 & OneDrive

The Technology Services team has been working to upgrade all faculty and staff computers to Office365. With this latest version of Office, you can take advantage of all the features of OneDrive! OneDrive allows you to save your files securely to the Cloud so you can work on them not only at your desk, but anywhere with an internet connection. No need to email yourself documents or save files in an unsecure, unsupported cloud storage, such as Dropbox.



Advantages of using OneDrive:

- Files accessible anywhere you have an internet connection
- 1 TB of storage space!
- Access previous versions of the same file
- Easily and securely share files with your team members no need to email files back and forth!
- No need to remember to save OneDrive automatically saves files as you work on them
- Files safe even if your computer fails OneDrive can automatically sync files saved on your desktop

Don't Take the Bait!

Phishing is to blame for 90% of data breaches with email being the weapon of choice for cyber criminals. That means YOU are the most important data security protection. Here are a few common tips to recognize potential phishing messages:

- The message was unexpected
- The message or request is urgent
- The greeting is generic such as "Dear Colleagues"
- The message contains an unexpected attachment
- The email contains a link directing you to a website asking you to enter your username and password

If you believe you have received a phishing email, and if you clicked on any links or opened any attachments on a suspicious email call the Helpdesk at x4357.
