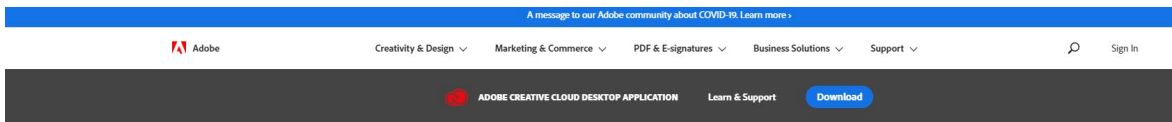


How To Download Adobe Creative Cloud App for Adobe DC

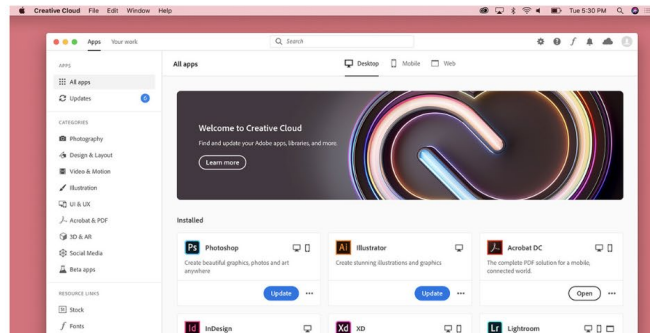
In order to get Adobe DC, which is the current version of adobe, you need to download the Adobe Creative Cloud Application.

Go to the following website: <https://www.adobe.com/creativecloud/desktop-app.html>. Your screen will look like this:

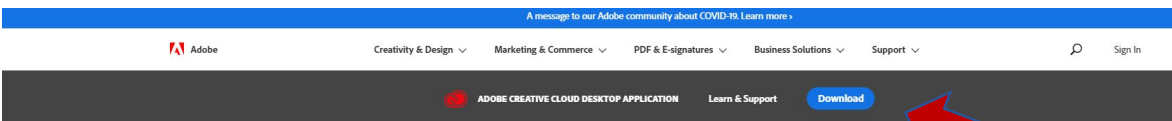


Easily manage your Creative Cloud apps and services.

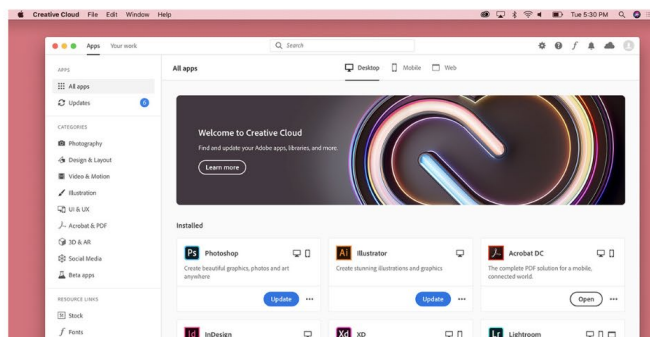


Now select "Download" to install the Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop Application.

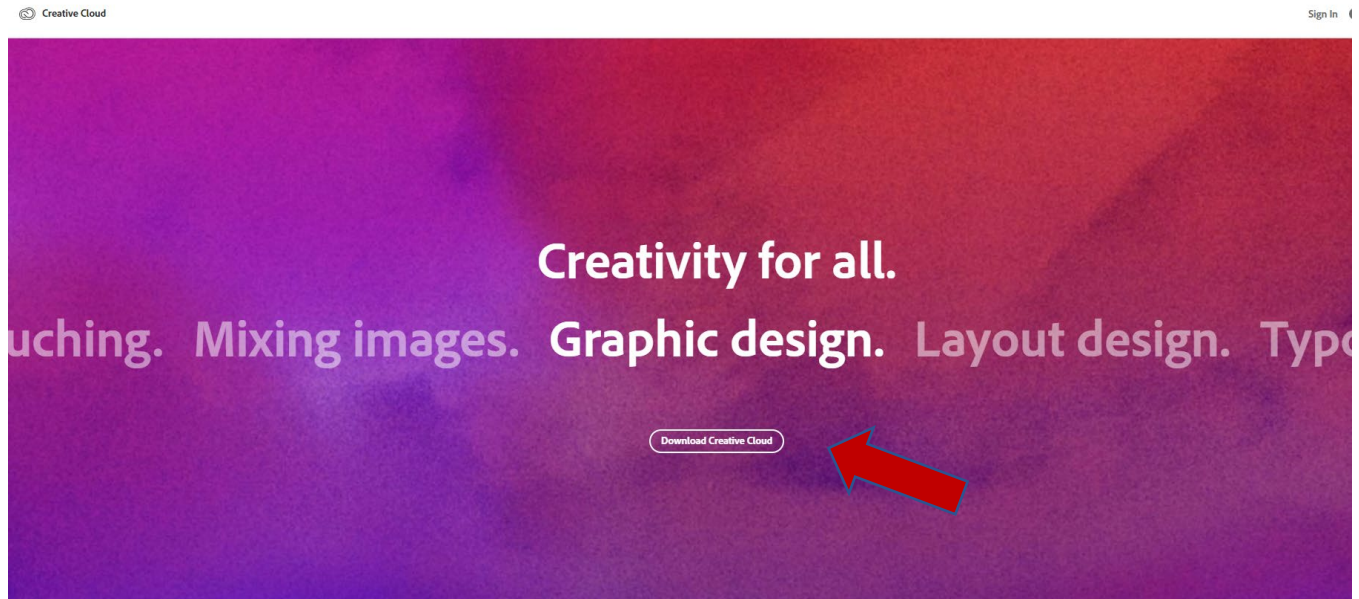

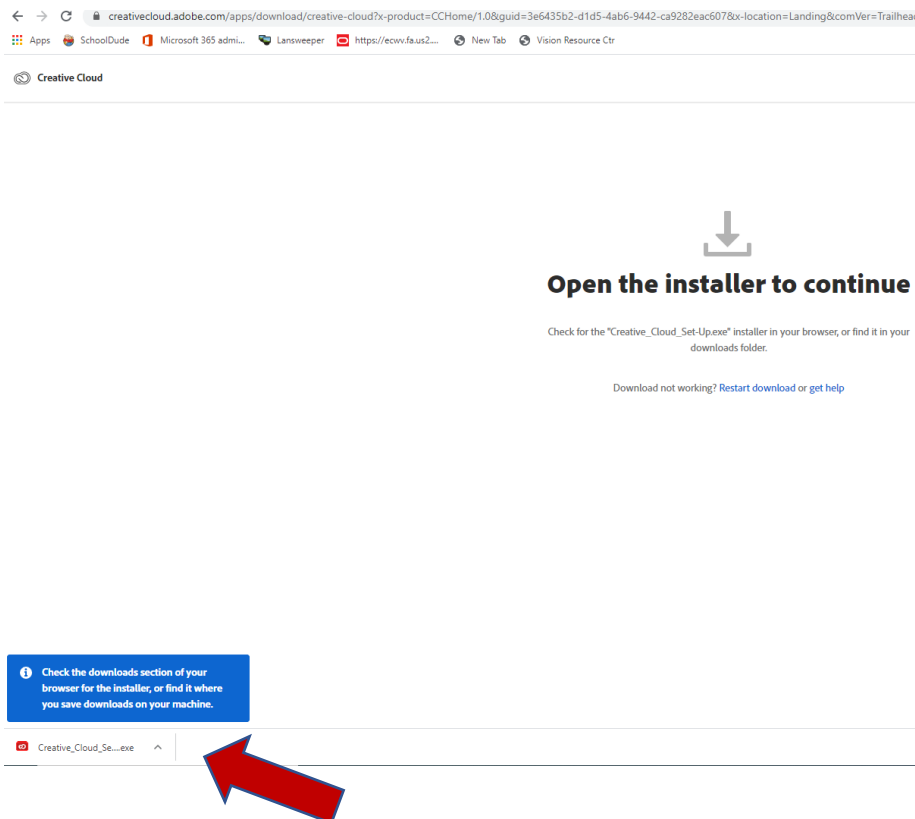

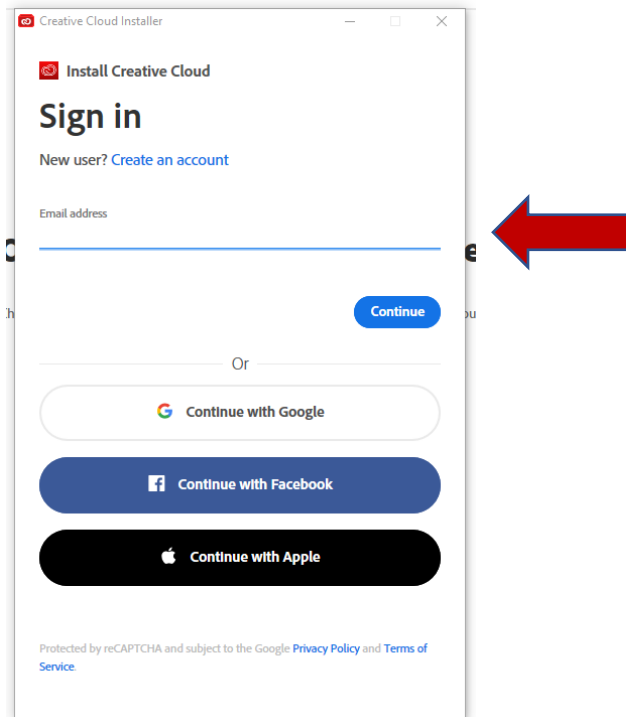
Once you select Download you will come to this screen:



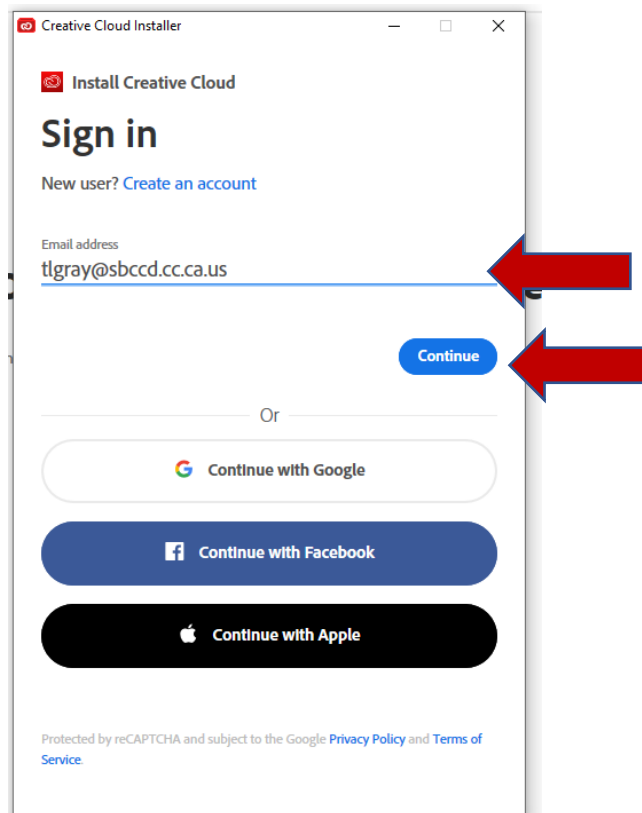
Select Download Creative Cloud. Your computer will download the .exe file to be able to install the Download. For Chrome you will find this on the bottom left of your screen. For Firefox it will show in your downloads.



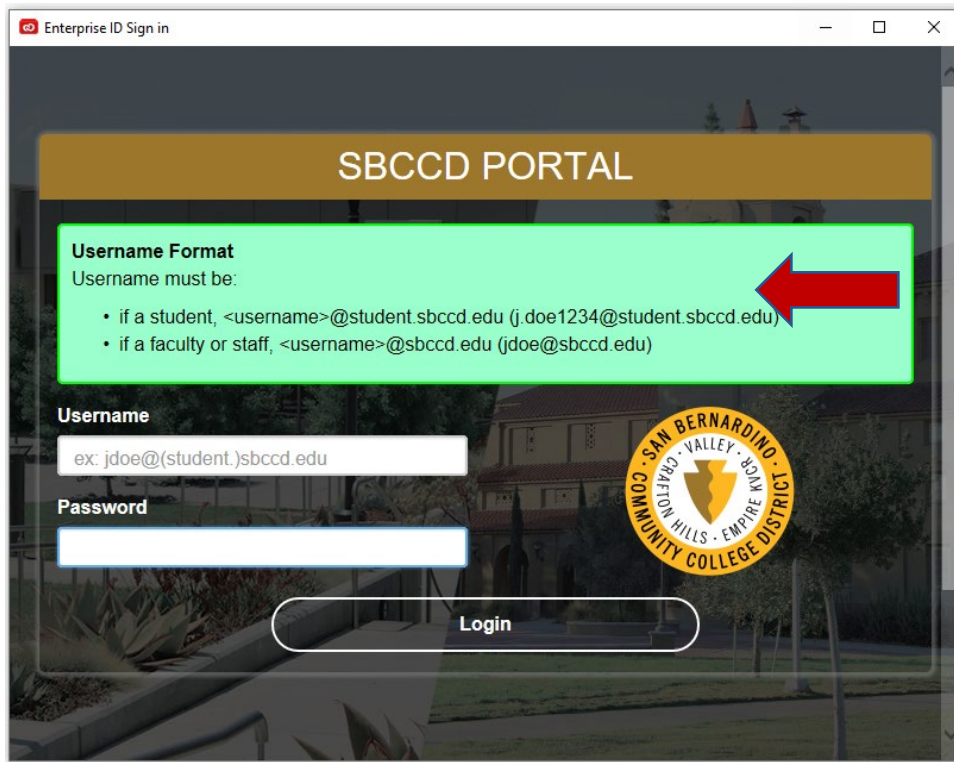
Once it is done downloading, click on the download and select “Open”. It will open a screen asking if you want to allow the app to make changes. You must select “Yes” for the program to download. You should get the following screen:



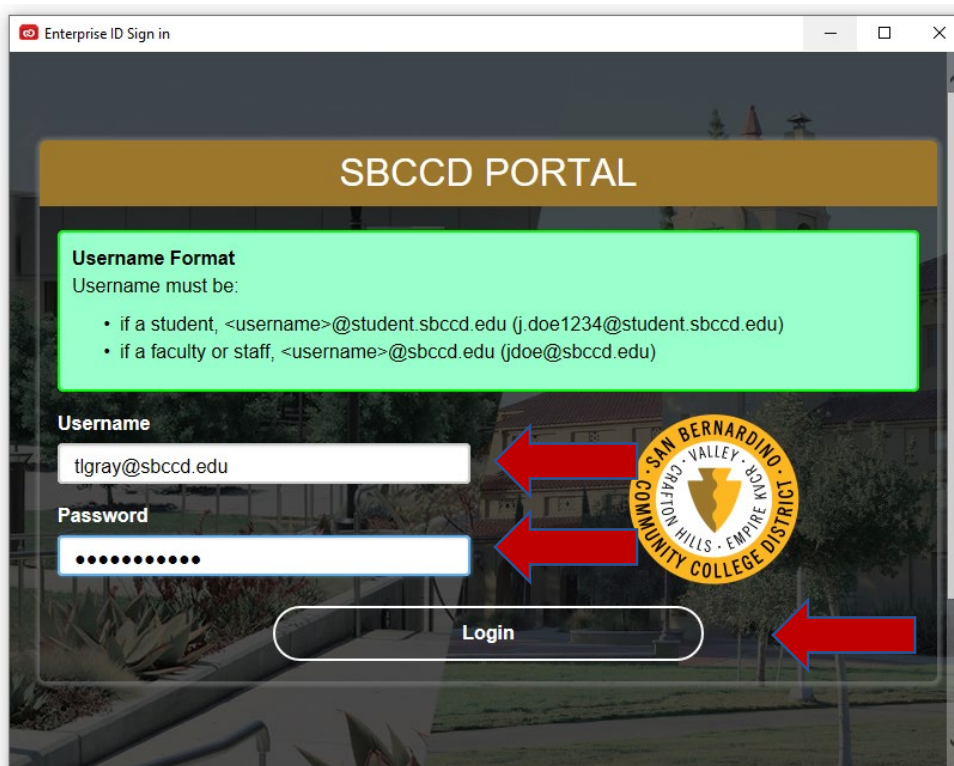
You will need to sign in with your @sbccd.cc.ca.us email address and then select Continue



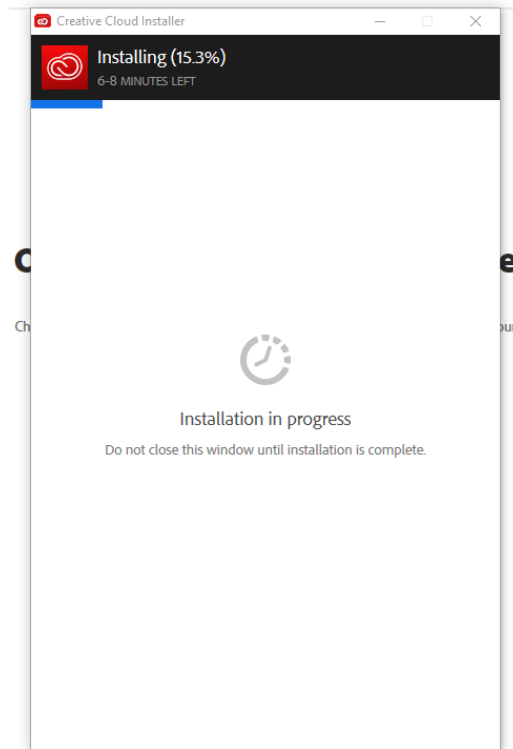
Once you hit continue you will be redirected again. Your screen will look like this:



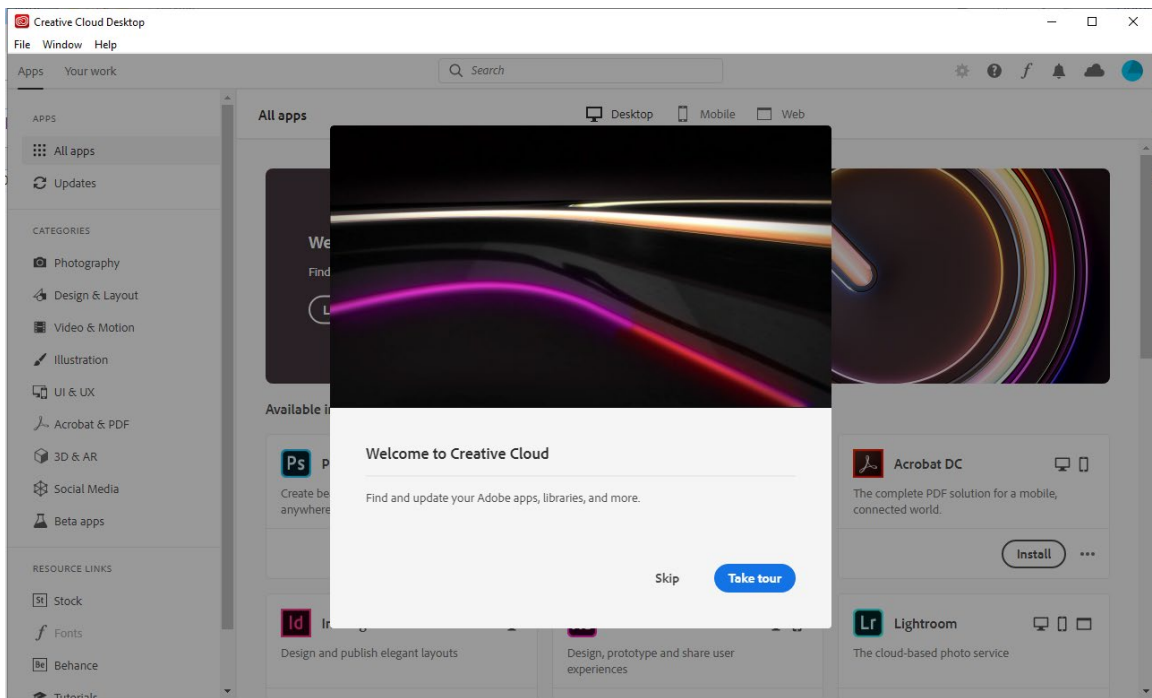
Here you must sign in using @sbccd.edu and you will use your current network password and select Login. Examples below. IF for some reason it won't take the password or says "Access Denied", please submit a Help Desk Ticket and/or contact Campus Technology Services so they can check to make sure you have a valid account with Adobe.



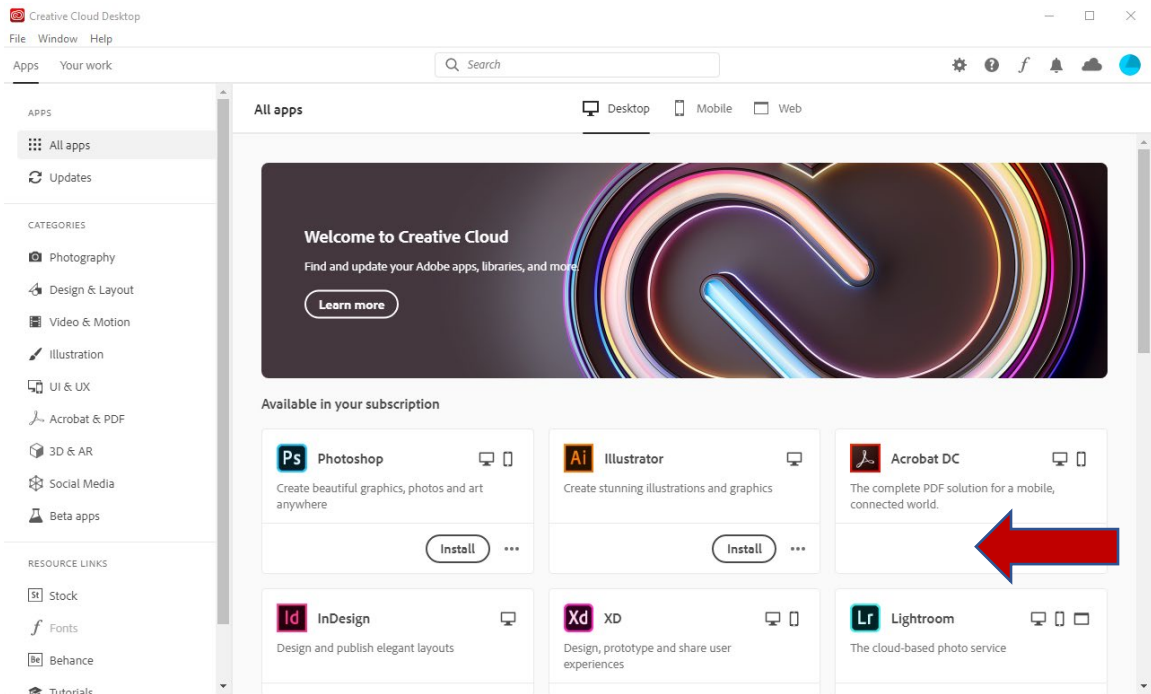
Once you select Login from the previous screen you will get the following screen. This is now installing the Adobe Creative Cloud App.



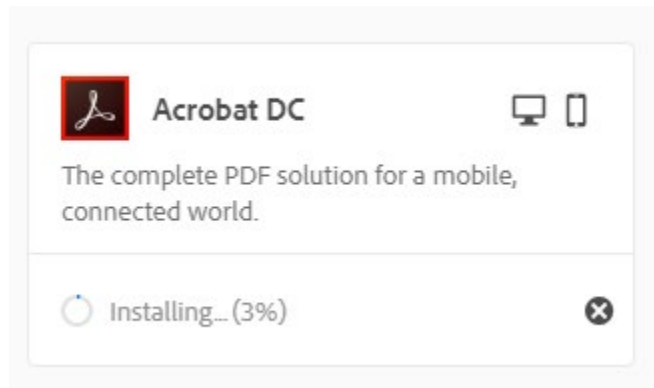
Once this process is done, the following screen will appear. You have now installed the Desktop App for Adobe. You can either go through the Tour or skip it.



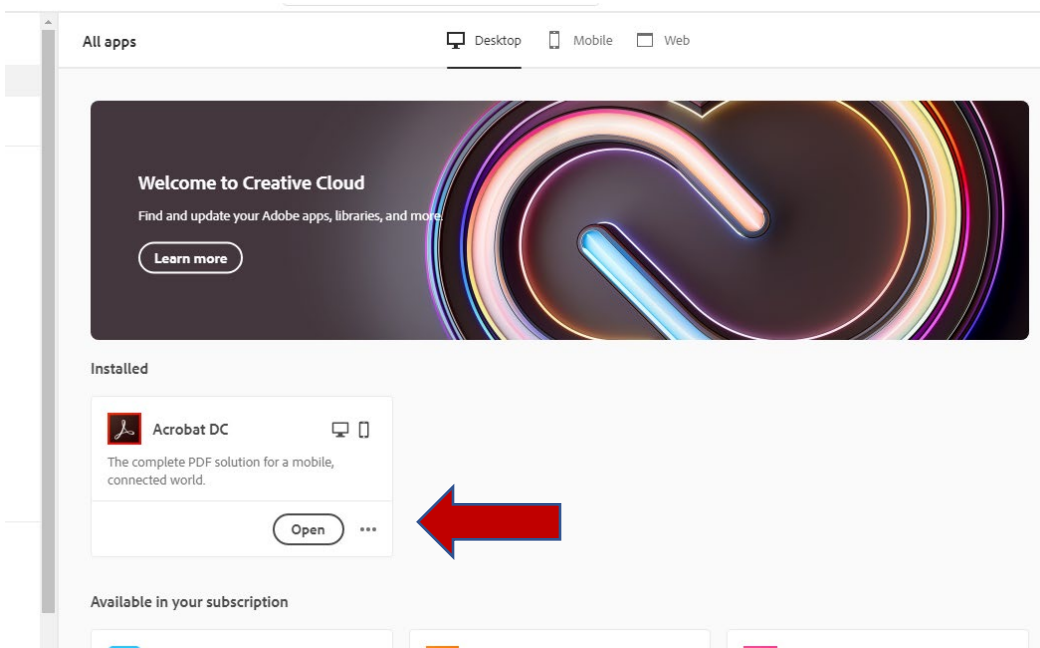
Once you are done or skip the tour you will see the apps for Adobe. You will need to Install Acrobat DC. You will see that in the list of Adobe applications. You will need to select Install under the Acrobat DC icon.



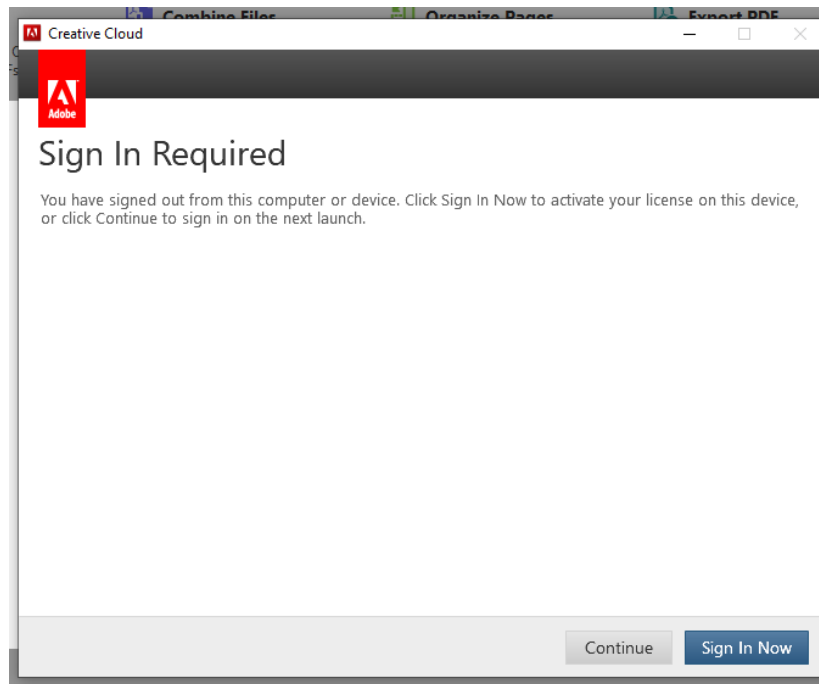
You will notice that it will start installing



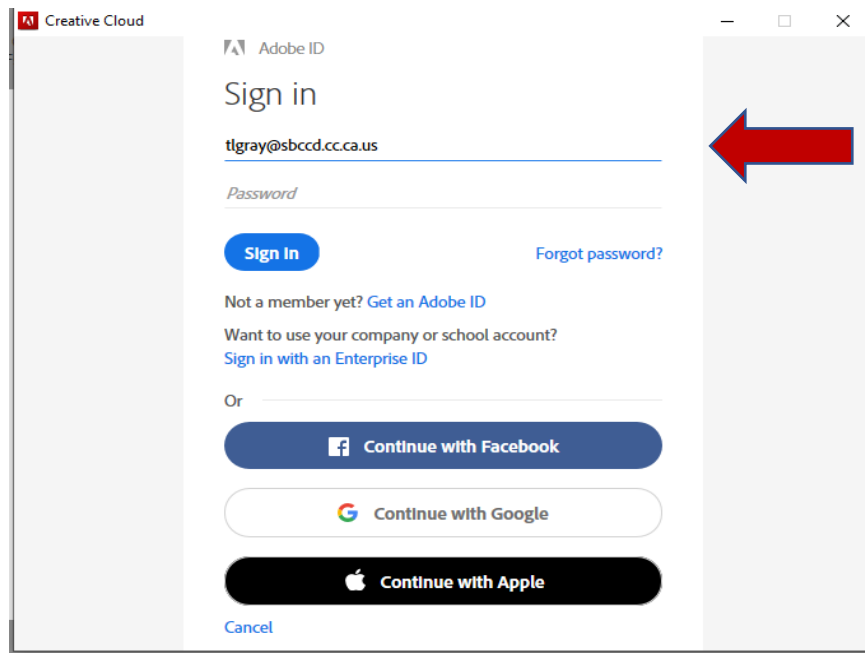
Once this is done, you will see that it was installed and now you need to open it.



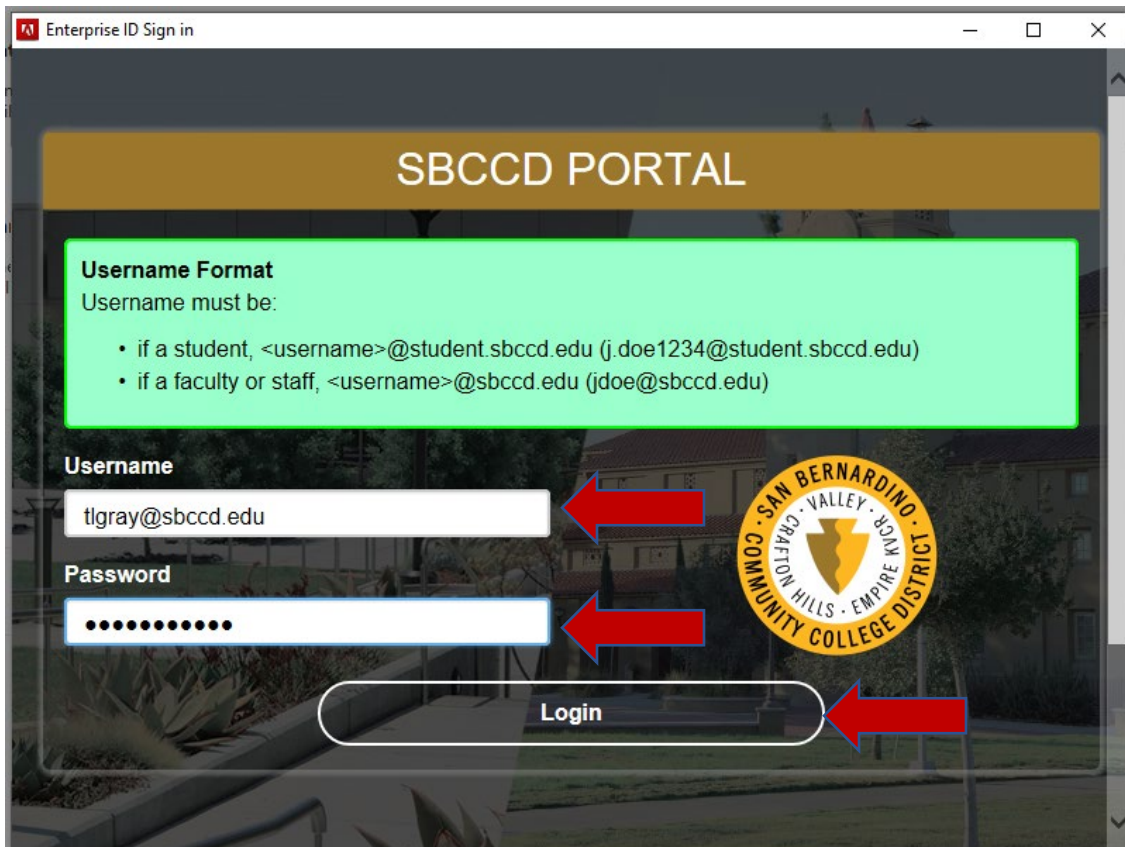
Once you open it you will be inside Adobe DC and it will likely prompt you to sign in. You MUST do this to have Adobe work. You will select "Sign In Now"



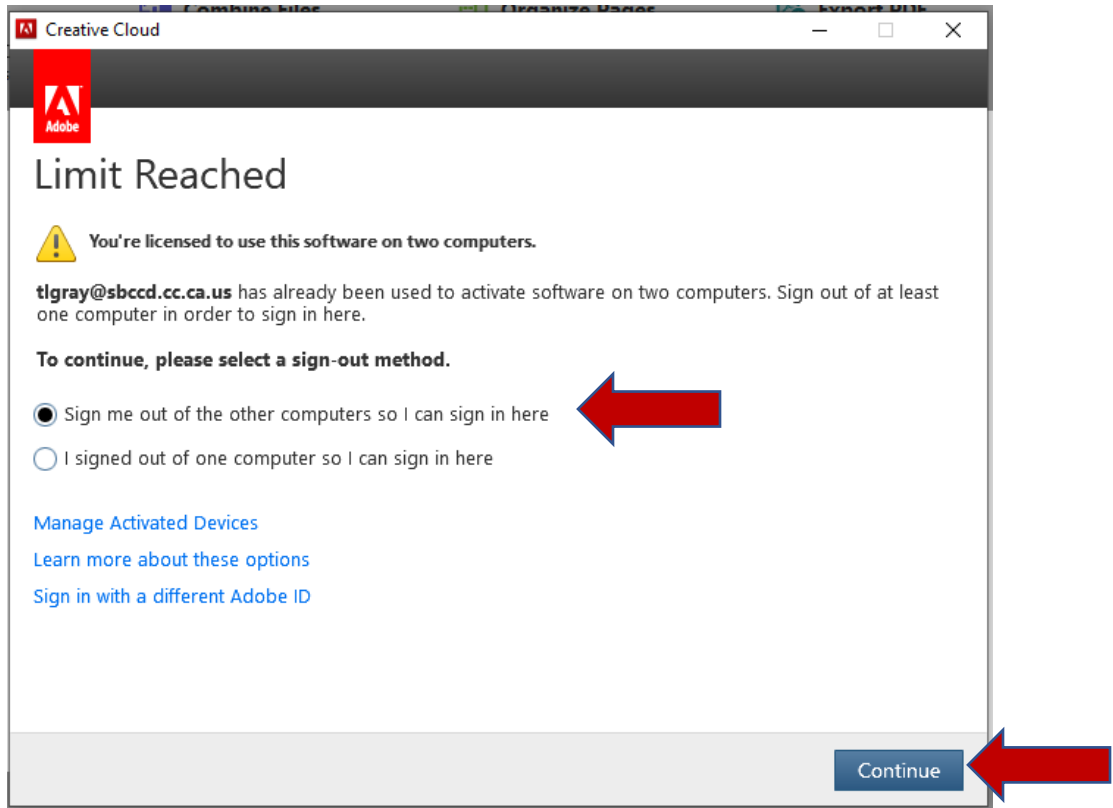
This will open the following box that you will sign in using your @sbccd.cc.ca.us email address.



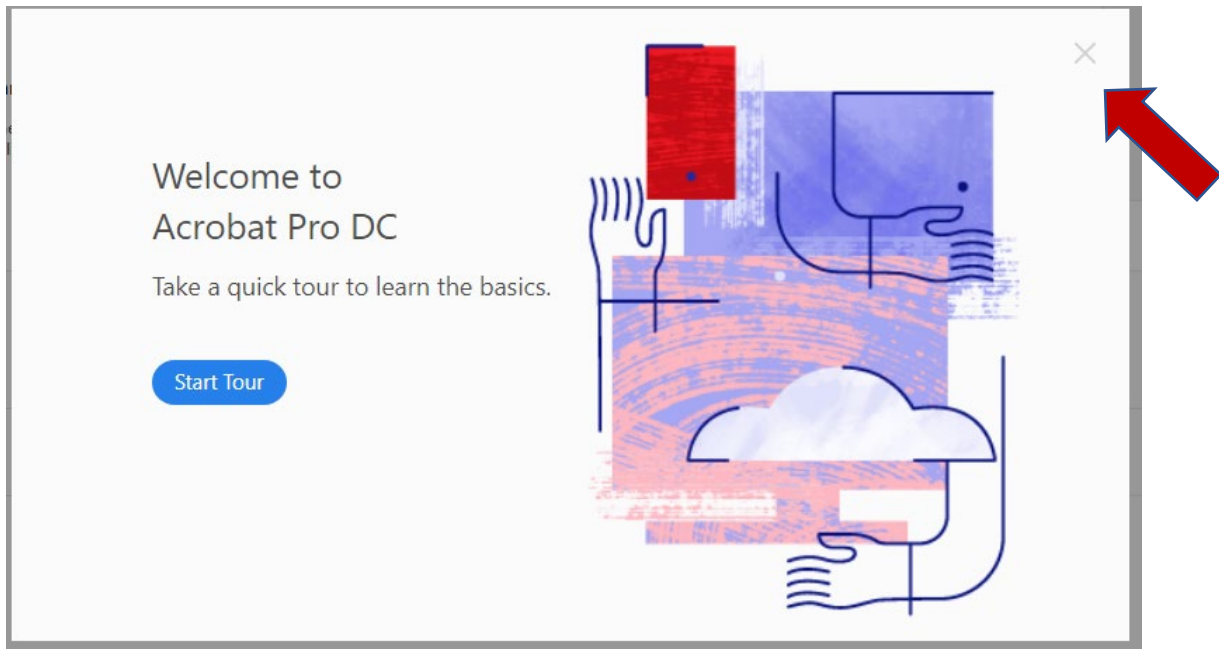
Again, you will be redirected to the SBCCD portal to sign in there with your email using @sbccd.edu and your current network login. Then select Login.



You MAY get the following screen. This is saying that you have logged into too many machines using your license. You only have 2 licenses for Adobe. Therefore, if you get this you will need to log out of one of the other machines. Leave the box marked to “Sign me out of other computers so I can sign in here” and select “Continue.”



You will now get the option to take a tour of Adobe DC or you can select the “X” to close it.



The following screen will appear and you are now ready to use Adobe DC
