Students will demonstrate language proficiency by writing and speaking Arabic at a beginning level.

Receptive Communication

Students will interpret written and spoken messages in Arabic at a beginning level.

Arabic-speaking Cultures

Students will demonstrate appropriate knowledge of the Arabic-speaking world regarding social interactions, beliefs, values, arts, literature, music and geography.

Cultural Diversity

Students will define the concept of culture, appreciate other cultures and interact with members of those cultures in relation to their own.

Life-long Learning

Students will apply their knowledge of Arabic language and Arab culture beyond the classroom in interactions within multicultural communities and the world.
