• Integrates training, equipment, and planning to design and develop a small-scale functional exercise.

 Utilizes an exercise program to build disaster-resistant and disaster-resilient communities.

### **Exercise Evaluation and Improvement Planning PBSF 122**

• Evaluates behaviors or activities against exercise objectives to develop an exercise improvement plan.
