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### 1) Scott Rippy: SB1440 Requirements for Transfer Degrees

- Scott went over certain excerpts from the SB1440 Bill.
  - Course Identification Numbering System (C-ID) has the following disciplines up for review: Accounting, Art History, Biology, Chemistry, Childhood Development, English, Geography, Geology, History, Kinesiology, Mathematics, Philosophy, Physical Education, Physics, Psychology, and Theatre
  - 6 transfer model curriculum degrees are now ready for review and feedback: Sociology, Communication Studies, Psychology, Geology, Math, and Criminal Justice.
  - Students must:
    - Complete 60 semester units or 90 quarter units that are eligible for transfer to the CSU system, including both of the following:
      - IGETC or CSU GE-breadth Requirements.
      - A minimum of 18 semester units or 27 quarter units in a major or area of emphasis, as determined by the community college district.
    - Obtain of a minimum grade point average of 2.0
  - Can participate in the C-ID effort to develop inter-segmental Model Curriculum Transfer Degrees (MCTD) by one of the following options:
    - Can model our transfer degrees after the MCTDs; approve them next semester; assuming other colleges do the same, our transfer degrees and their coursework will be more readily accepted at other colleges and the CSUs.
    - We make up our own transfer degree within the requirements of the new law; approve them next semester; students who might transfer between colleges before finishing the degree might experience more difficulty in the transition.
  - We need at least 2 transfer degrees in place soon and we need 2 disciplines to volunteer to do this.
  - We need a Transfer Degree Committee to be comprised for Scott Rippy, Judy Harrington, and faculty from the 2 volunteering disciplines. The committee will meet for guidance/information and review purposes to aid the discipline faculty in writing degrees that meet the requirements of the new law.
  - The Academic Senate should ask the Curriculum Committee to expedite the process when considering these transfer degrees for approval.
