Curriculum

- Review and approve curriculum as submitted in a timely manner.
- Provide continued training to faculty in the process of writing curriculum, CurricuNet, and Title 5 changes.

Educational Policy

- Make recommendations regarding board policy and college procedures regarding the admission of minor students.
- Investigate and make recommendations regarding a statement regarding faculty rights and responsibilities regarding dropping students from classes.
- Investigate and make recommendation regarding education policies regarding acceptance of CLEP scores, residency requirements for a certificate, the applicability of upper division work to general education, and multiple degrees.
- Investigate and make recommendations regarding the implementation of an "FW" grade.
- Investigate the effect of implementing a plus/minus grading system.

Personnel Interests

- Draft a faculty profile/statement of expectations of probationary and tenured faculty.
- Plan and execute the Classified Appreciation Luncheon
- Conduct "Professor of the Year" and "Classified Staff of the Year" balloting.
- Offer suggested procedures regarding the selection and evaluation of faculty chairs.
- Offer suggested procedures regarding the hiring and re-employment of part-time faculty.
- Investigate and make recommendations regarding strategies to increase involvement of part-time faculty

Scholarship

- Draft revised Academic Honesty policy.
- Investigate and make recommendations regarding a statement of best practices in constructing syllabi.
- Determine 2008 scholarship recipients according to identified criteria.

Student Interests

- Make a recommendation to the College President regarding a commencement speaker.
- Investigate and make recommendations to the faculty regarding strategies to offset the increased price of textbooks.
