Faculty Scholarship Criteria and Process

The Faculty Scholarship is awarded to all Crafton Hills College students who will graduate in Spring semester or have graduated in the most recent Summer and Fall semesters who earn an associate degree with a 4.0 cumulative GPA.

- 1. In the spring semester of each academic year, following the deadline to file a petition for graduation, the Treasurer of the Academic Senate will obtain a list of graduating students who are eligible for the Faculty Scholarship
- 2. Eligibility is limited to those students, who at that time have petitioned to graduate with an associate degree and are believed to have a 4.0 cumulative GPA as well as those who were granted a degree in the most recent Summer and Fall semesters and earned a 4.0 cumulative GPA.
- 3. The Treasurer of the Academic Senate will announce the number of students who are eligible for the scholarship to the Academic Senate at which time it will be decided how much the scholarship will be awarded for that year. The goal of the Academic Senate should be to award the greatest amount possible, given the number of students and the funds available in the Faculty Council account.
- 4. Student Services notifies the eligible students by mail to attend Honors Convocation where student is formally notified of the award and receives an envelope naming him/her a recipient of the Academic Senate Scholarship, pending final certification after the degree is posted. A form, similar to those used for other scholarships, will be used to notify the student of final eligibility requirements. The student must turn in the completed form to receive his/her scholarship check.
- 5. The Treasurer and President of the Academic Senate will certify which of the eligible recipients will in fact receive the scholarship and write checks to those students which can be picked up from the Vice President of Student Services office within one year.
