Recommendations from Scholarship Committee

Background

For the past several years the Academic Senate has awarded money to graduating students who maintain a 4.0 gpa during their tenure at Crafton Hills College.

Last spring (See April 1, 2009 Minutes) the Academic Senate voted changes in criteria for the Faculty Scholarship which resulted in greater difficulty for those eligible students – announced during Honors Convocation - to actually receive the money. (For example, students were asked to show proof of further enrollment.)

Recommended Changes

While the Scholarship Committee welcomes most of the voted changes in policy from last spring, we recommend the following modifications:

- 1. That the Faculty Scholarship, given to 4.0 degree eligible students, be considered an award for excellent academic work, and therefore, bestowed as soon as possible without proof of enrollment in a subsequent semester.
- 2. That proof of 4.0 status will be that gpa verified by Records Office at the time of Honors Convocation.
