

Data about 900-level classes

The percent of students who started at the lowest 900 level course and earned a degree, certificate, or transferred from 2007 – 2008 to 2009 – 2010.

Math: 8 out 819 (1.0%) earned a degree, 14 out 819 (1.7%) earned a certificate, and 14 out of 819 (1.7%) transferred.

Reading and English: 4 out of 545 (0.7%) earned a degree, 6 out 545 (1.1%) earned a certificate, and 5 out of 545 (0.9%)
