Resolution F07.02 Granting Credit for Graduate Coursework

Whereas, The primary mission of the community college is to provide career-technical education or prepare students for transfer to an undergraduate institution;

Whereas, This mission is achieved through offering lower-division, undergraduate coursework;

Whereas, Lower-division, undergraduate coursework is qualitatively different in content, scope, and intensity and serves a characteristically different purpose from specialized graduate coursework;

Whereas, Students with graduate coursework who return to the community college for retraining will putatively have completed undergraduate coursework which can be applied toward an associate degree or certificate;

Resolved, That the Crafton Hills College Academic Senate recommend that graduate coursework not be accepted toward an associate degree or certificate.
