

Population Demographics of Crafton's Primary Service Area Cities

Purpose of Brief

The purpose of this brief is to provide a method for programs to proportionally compare gender, ethnicity, and age to the students they serve in their own programs.

Summary of Findings

- 52% of the total population in CHC'S Primary Service Area (PSA) is female.
- 44% of the total population in CHC's PSA is 50years old or older, 17% of the total population is 40 – 49 years old, and 9.4% of the total population is 20 – 24 years old.
- 55% of the population in CHC's PSA is Caucasian and 31% is Hispanic.
- 14% of the total population in CHC's PSA has a disability.
- 12% of the total population in CHC's PSA live below the poverty threshold.
- 0.1% of the total population in CHC's PSA are foster youth.
- 9% of the total population in CHC's PSA are veterans.

Overview

The purpose of this brief is to provide a method for programs to proportionally compare gender, ethnicity, and age to the students they serve in their own programs. Rather than only comparing information from cities in the San Bernardino Community College District, a more methodologically sound comparison involves comparing Crafton Hills College (CHC) program demographics to the cities CHC primarily serves students. Accordingly, Primary Service Area (PSA) cities were defined as cities where 2% or more of the total population in the city earned a grade on record (GOR, A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I, or W) at Crafton. The city did not have to be in the San Bernardino Community College District (SBCCD) to be a PSA city. CHC serves 2% or more of the population in the following five cities: Beaumont, Calimesa, Mentone, Redlands, and Yucaipa.

Methodology

The data included was exported from the United States Census Bureau database, using the [FactFinder tool](#). Different tables were referenced, based on the necessary information. The tables accessed through the American Community Survey (ACS) included the following tables: B01001, B03002, B18101, B17001, B09019, and S2101. Table B01001 was used for Table 1 (gender) and Table 2 (age), where males and females reported in the age categories of 18 years and older were summed, then categorized accordingly. Table B03002 was used for ethnicity in Table 3, where ethnicities listed as "Not Hispanic or Latino" and "White alone" was coded as Caucasian, "Black or African American alone" were coded as African American, "American Indian and Alaska Native alone" were coded as Native American, "Asian alone" was coded as Asian, "Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander alone" were coded as Native American, "Some other race alone" was coded as Other/Unknown, and "Two or more races" were coded as 2 or More Races. All individuals listed as "Hispanic or Latino" were coded as Hispanic. Table B18101 was used for Disability Status for males and females in the age categories of 18 years and older were summed, then categorized respectively where "With a disability" was coded as Disability and "No disability" was coded in the same way. Table B17001 was used for Poverty Status where "Income in the past 12 months below poverty level" was coded as Poverty and "Income in the past 12 months at or above poverty level" was coded as Above Poverty; while also only including males and females 18 years and older.

Table B09019 was used for Foster Youth Status where “Foster Child” was coded as Foster Youth and “All Households” less “Foster Child” was coded as Not a Foster Youth. Table S2101 was used for Veteran Status where “Veterans” was coded as Veteran and “Nonveteran” was coded as Not a Veteran.

Findings

Tables 1 and 2 illustrate the number and percent of the population in Beaumont, Calimesa, Mentone, Redlands, and Yucaipa for those who are eighteen years old or older. Table 3 demonstrates the entire population in each of the five PSA cities by ethnicity. It wasn't possible to identify ethnicity for the 18 and over population in all five cities; accordingly, ethnicity is shown for the entire population of each city. Table 4 illustrates disability status for the population 18 years and older for all of CHC's primary service areas. Table 5 demonstrates poverty status for the population 18 years and older in all of the five PSA cities. Finally, Table 7 illustrates the number and percent of the population 18 years and older in all of the five PSA cities, by veteran status.
