Canvas and Starfish are now integrated! What does this mean for you?

Aside from being able to access Starfish from your Canvas shell and being able to see students' grades in Starfish, you can now opt-in to automatic flags for low grades and/or inactivity in Canvas.

Automatic flags for low grades: As long as users enter grades in Canvas, Starfish can send automatic flags when a student's current grade falls below a specified threshold. Each instructor can set their own threshold for their courses. In order to opt-in, email Breanna Andrews with the following information:

Automatic flags for inactivity (not logging in) to Canvas: This is a great flag for online courses, but could apply to any course that requires consistent use of Canvas. This flag will be assigned to students who have not logged into Canvas in a specified amount of consecutive calendar days.
