

#### Student Services Example: Extended Opportunities Programs & Services (EOP&S), Fall 2009:



1. SAO – Students understand that they are responsible for their own success in college, and take ownership through decision-making and positive action.




## 5. Possible Use of Results (Implications for Program Improvement & Planning) –

EXAMPLE — Greater emphasis on early identification of/intervention for high-risk students. Develop means of planning workshops that target student needs. Develop strategies to increase attendance at workshops and use of tutoring services. Implement these strategies and reassess their effectiveness.

# 2. Means of Assessment (Measurement Method) –

Recognition/tracking of positive student participation in program activities for FA 09 semester.



### 4. Summary of Data Collected (Results)

- Over 55% of students rated as adequate or excellent, these students are twice as likely to use tutoring and attend workshops than those rated below adequate (45%).
