1. Learning Outcomes Statement

Students will communicate information effectively to an audience.

2. Means of Assessment (Measurement Method)

Students deliver a short class presentation that demonstrates the student's ability to determine a need for information, locate that information, evaluate and use the information in a legal and ethical manner. Students are scored on a scale of 0-3 where 0 indicates no demonstrated achievement, 1 indicates minimal evidence of achievement, 2 indicates adequate evidence of achievement, and 3 indicates significant evidence of achievement. Students are scored on audience awareness, posture and eye contact, word choice, content, use of time and confidence.

3. Criteria for Success (Benchmark)

4. Summary of Evidence

Nineteen of the 33 students (58%) received credit for acceptable speeches.

5. Use of Results (Implications for Program Improvement & Planning)
