1. Student Learning Outcomes Statement

Students will participate fully in shared governance committees.

2. Means of Assessment (Measurement Method)

In the 2011 – 2012 academic year identify the number and percent of students sitting on a shared governance committee who were assigned and interacted with a mentor on a regular basis.

3. Criteria for Success (Benchmark)

80% of the students sitting on a shared governance committee will have interacted with a mentor on a regular basis.

4. Summary of Evidence

Since the plan was submitted in Spring 2011, every student rep on shared governance committees for Fall 2011 was assigned a mentor and met at least once with their mentor to discuss their committee assignments. There has been less participation in shared governance on behalf of students in Spring 2012 due to changing school schedules and increased activity levels.

5. Use of Results (Implications for Program Improvement & Planning)

The Director of Student Life plans to create a new plan to address selection and retention of Spring semester reps during Summer 2012. The new plan for selection and retention of Student Reps is slated to be implemented mid Fall 2012. In addition, Student Life will work with the ORP to develop a new survey or revise the <u>Student Shared Governance Survey</u> that will assess how engaged students participating on shared governance committees are during the 2012-2013 academic year.
